Perhaps you, or someone you know, has started (maybe several times!) their Basic Aeronautical Knowledge (BAK) or Private Pilot Licence (PPL) theory but did not sit or pass the exam? Life interruptions can make achieving such things difficult and we have found many in this predicament. The services of our SAAA Chapter 11 President have been retained to conduct a focused and practical PPL theory course commencing initially with a knowledge challenge test to see where everybody is up to. Subject to ascertaining the needs of the group, the course will run over six weekday nights in a classroom at corporate premises in Castle Hill. Additional tuition may be made available if required at extra cost.

Notes:

1. This “fast track course” takes into account that you have previously studied most of the theory for the BAK & PPL exam. If you have not commenced any study, it is likely you will require more tuition than this course will offer. Please let us know if this is the case and we will look to organising a more comprehensive additional course at a later date (numbers permitting) , and,
2. If you feel completely rusted up, don't worry...the course leader will provide “practical tips” and refresher tasks to complete prior to the course commencing.
